Imagine a land of lush woods and forests, pristine lakes, scenic mountains and free flowing rivers, a landscape of natural wonders that characterized our first national parks.

That's exactly the kind of environment you will find at a new luxury lifestyle spot called Grey Rock at Lake Lure in North Carolina. This new resort-like development, located up in the Blue Ridge Mountains on 4,000 acres of prime forested land just southeast of Asheville, is one of the most scenic areas in the country. In addition, golfers have access to approximately 50 golf courses within a 45-minute radius of the area, and if you're a skier, there are great slopes conveniently located within an hour's drive.

What makes Grey Rock so appealing, apart from the untouched natural beauty is the sense of privacy in a national park setting. With this serene atmosphere, the area has earned a reputation as a great place to get away from it all, and even to work. The incredible lake and mountain views continually serve as an inspiration to stimulate

the creative juices of the creative types. The mountainous location also provides a natural barrier against overdevelopment, so there will never be a concern about overcrowding.


A big plus for those who want city-life amenities, Asheville is only a 30-minute drive from Grey Rock. The largest city in western NC, with a metro area population of nearly half-million, Asheville has placed well on numerous "best" lists, including *The Happiest Place in the U.S.* in Eric Weiner's book, *The Geography of Bliss*, and was also named one of the top seven places to live in the U.S. in a recent *Frommer's Guide*. Asheville offers numerous activities and nightlife with clubs, live music venues, theaters, festivals, museums and a wealth of first class restaurants in many different cuisines.

Lake Lure, with 23 miles of coastline, is a

crown jewel for buyers who purchase stunning lake view for themselves, but sometimes also end up purchasing additional lots as investments in other parts of Grey Rock. The strong demographic growth in the area has helped maintain continued strong appreciation, which, in this economy, translates into excellent values and investment opportunities.

With this strong appreciation, Grey Rock has equally become an excellent choice for second or third home buyers. "We are excited about the investment returns that the area is generating," says Berg.
