This first event—at The Fine Arts Theatre, in Beverly Hills was the kickoff to the many extraordinary *Sex to Success* seminars that will take place each month starting in September, at the Park Hyatt Hotel, in Century City.

Celebrities, international guest speakers, television/radio personalities, best-selling authors, sex therapists and visionaries in the world of health and anti-aging—plus a to-die-for fashion show by Designer to the Stars and owner of the hottest retail boutique on Sunset Boulevard—"On Sunset"—Shauna Stein and high fashion accessories extraordinaire Cynthia Desser.

After a personal note to the audience, Devine introduced multi-talented Carol Connors, nominated for 10 major music awards including Emmys, Grammys, Golden Globes and two Oscars—one for co-writing the *ROCKY* theme. Connors has performed at Inaugurations and celebrations for President

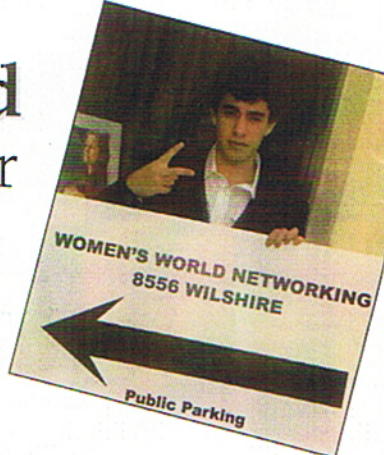
